About the Music Conservatory of Westchester

The Music Conservatory of Westchester (www.musicconservatoryonline.org) is a non-profit community school of the arts, providing outstanding music, musical theatre, and music therapy programs for all ages and abilities. The Conservatory's 36,000-square-foot facility in White Plains offers a Recital Hall and 43 acoustically designed classrooms and teaching studios – all available to rent. Their comprehensive programs include performing ensembles, musicianship classes, music therapy, student performances, rock band, master classes, workshops, and more. All students receive free admission to the Conservatory's annual "Live on Central" concert series of faculty recitals and children's concerts. This year, the Conservatory awarded \$110,000 in scholarship support and tuition assistance to more than 115 of its students. The Conservatory is chartered by the New York State Board of Regents, a member of the National Guild for Community Arts Education, and is one of only 19 non-degree granting institutions in the country to be fully accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music. The Conservatory receives public funds from the New York State Council on the Arts (NYSCA), celebrating 50 years of building strong, creative communities in New York State's 62 counties.
